

## **RHUBARB FARM BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT MANAGER**

**Rhubarb Farm CIC, a horticultural social enterprise in Langwith, on the north Notts/Derbs border, seeks to appoint a Business Development Manager to develop new business opportunities for the Farm.**

The post is part-time, 24 hours per week, £35,000 pro rata, and in the first instance is fixed term for one year commencing from appointment date.

We welcome applications from suitably experienced and qualified people with a minimum track record of 5 years in business development and a proven track record of success in getting businesses off the ground, generating income and/or securing funding through private or public funders.

This post will be a challenging and demanding one, with a target to raise three times the salary for this post within one year.
